Consensus Building among Stakeholders - Participatory Planning of Coastal Zone in Komatsujima

In 1999, in connection with the progress of the mid-term development strategy of the port facilities in Komatsujima, Tokushima prefecture, authors facilitated the planing process using various participatory tools, in order to resolve the conflicts among users of the area.
